Terms, Conditions & Registration Form for the Tour of the Millennium, Sep 29 – Oct 13, 2011

Early Registration Tour Cost

\$4,895 per person, double occupancy

\$9,790 per couple double occupancy

Includes – Round trip airfare & land package

Registration is based on first come first served. These tours sell out early, so we strongly suggest you book early to reserve your space. Tour prices could be affected by additional costs for airfare and/or the Euro.

Registration deposit: To register and reserve your space, send a minimum of **\$250** per person. You have the option to pay in full to lock in your tour cost with a full refund up to **November 1, 2010** except **\$50** per person admin fee. To keep our costs to an absolute minimum, we do not accept credit cards.

After November 1, 2010 - 2nd Payment due: \$2,500 per person for a total of **\$5,500** per couple with initial registration deposit is due and 50% of trip cost is non-refundable. (Ask about Cancellation Insurance.)

After June 1, 2011 - Full payment due. Total tour cost - **100% non-refundable.** Cancellation & medical travel insurance is strongly suggested.

Tour Cancellation / Interruption & Medical Insurance: We strongly urge you to give favorable consideration to coverage which provides financial protection for expenses related to cancellation, trip interruption and medical expenses caused by a covered reason as stated in the policy. We recommend **Access America Insurance Services at 1-800-284-8300.** Go to www.accessamerica.com for more information or to purchase online. Include our agency number **F027712.** This policy pays for loss of deposits and additional expense due to unforeseen illness, injuries to you, a traveling partner or immediate family member. It also covers lost baggage, travel documents, missed connection expenses, medical expense, emergency assistance and accidental death. We can also mail you brochure for your review. This is a separate insurance plan, and not connected to **Crisp Tours**, however, we will help you through your claim should it become necessary. The easiest way to get coverage - **call us.** We will take out your policy for you with your credit card and send you a receipt.

Foreign exchange: The major risk factor in pricing your trip is based on the cost of the Euro. For every .01 increase above 1.50 Euro to the dollar, there will be an increase of \$25 per person. For example, if the exchange rate becomes 1.52 to one dollar when you make your final payment, there will be an increase of \$50 per person. To lock in your tour price, you may wish to prepay your trip early. This will enable us to move your money into Euros and your trip cost will not increase if the Euro increases in value to the dollar. Since we must forecast and make deposits far in advance, there are no refunds should the Euro decrease.

Not included: Entrance fees to attractions not listed as advertised, excess baggage, personal items, telephone calls, trip cancellation & medical insurance, laundry, beverages, lunches, two evening meals, food and drink items not on our scheduled menus.

Tour prices are based on two persons sharing one room. **Single room supplements** are available for singles wishing to have a private room for an additional **\$400 per person**

Responsibility: We have made arrangements with airlines, hotels and other independent suppliers to provide you with the services you purchased. If you are departing before or returning later than the scheduled tour, or wish to do your own air arrangements, please let us know not later than **November 1, 2010.**

Land Package Only: If you wish to do your own air arrangements, subtract \$750 per person. You will also be responsible for your own transportation to and from Grassau. You can arrange to meet our bus at the Munich Airport. If your schedule does not allow you to meet our bus, we can arrange van transportation to or from the Munich Airport at your expense. Meet the Staff

Jerry Story started calling at the young age of 14 in Fairfield, IA. He married his high school sweetheart, Kristy in 1976 who was in his second beginner class. Two children, Joshua and Jacob, soon followed and his career picked up momentum. He found himself touring full time calling dances and festivals coast to coast and in a dozen different countries. Many recordings of Jerry's calling and teaching were made available to new dancers and callers throughout the world and have had a

great influence in the growth of square dancing, especially in Saudi Arabia and Sweden.

Jerry and Kristy raised their sons in Mission, Texas while operating a very exciting square dancing program at the Peppermint Palace. In the spring of 2002, Jerry and Kristy, along with lifetime friend and business partner Tony Oxendine, opened Pride RV Resort in Maggie Valley, NC. Pride Center offers a 3000 sq. ft. floating hardwood floor, perfect for dancing with its built in concert sound system.

Jerry has been co-owner of Royal Records since 1985 and has numerous hit records to his credit. His gospel CD "Wings of a Dove", recorded in Nashville has sold thousands of copies worldwide. He has served as a Board of Governors' member in CALLERLAB and is dedicated to the preservation of Modern Western Square Dancing.

Tony Oxendine has emerged as one of the most popular and sought after national callers for festivals and special dances. His professional musical background and natural ability has enabled reach an incredible vocal range unmatched by any other professional caller. He is a graduate of SC University, majoring in math and computer science – a perfect match for developing a choreographic callers' mentality. He travels over 300 days a year doing dances worldwide. He is an accredited caller coach, continues to serve on the CALLERLAB board of governors and has served as the organizations chairman of the board. Tony is the recipient of CALLERLAB's highest honor, the precious Milestone Award.

Tony is Editor of *Square Dancing Today*, the largest full-color, full size worldwide square dance magazine. In the spring of 2002, Tony, along with his lifetime buddies Jerry Story and Larry Letson opened Pride RV Resort and Maggie Valley Square Dance Vacations in Maggie Valley, NC.

Tom Crisp started calling in 1968 while stationed with the Canadians in Germany and has been active ever since. He has served as president of the European Callers & Teachers Association, the training director and conducted several tours and vacation weeks while in Germany. Tom currently travels as a guest caller for clubs in and around the state of Arizona. He especially enjoys contras, quadrilles and traditional squares.

Your tour hosts, **Tom & Gina**, live in Tucson AZ where they operate a self-care horse ranch. Gina comes from the small Bavarian village of Koenigsdorf just south of Munich. They were married in Bad Toelz, Germany in 1964 and have two children and four grandchildren; two are currently going to the U of A.
